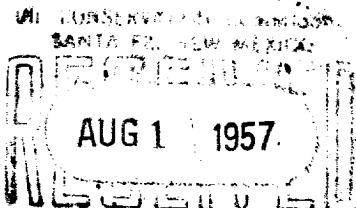

Gentlemen:

As a result of a recent action by the Oil Conservation Commission in issuing Order No. B-1614, we have assigned 178.73 acres to Skelly Oil Company's L. L. McConnell Well No. 2 unit, letter P, in Section 31, Township 25 North, Range 3 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as a result of which this well was placed in the North Blanco Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool.

The proposed nonstandard proration unit consists of more than 160 acres and the unorthodox size and shape of the tract is entirely due to variation of the legal subdivision of the United States public land survey. We respectfully request administrative approval for a nonstandard proration unit since it consists of contiguous quarter quarter section lying wholly within a single governmental section and is surrounded by producing gas wells. All interests in these lands are under common ownership, with Skelly Oil Company being the operator thereof. By carbon copy of this letter we are requesting waiver from the offset operators, J.
