Dear Mr. Holland:

You have inquired about El Paso Natural Gas #36-D State well in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 36-25N-2W.

Our records indicate Notice of Intention to Drill was filed on this well February 14, 1957 by San Juan Gas Corporation. The well was subsequently drilled to a total depth of 3612 feet in the top of the Lewis Shale, top of the Pictured Cliffs being at 3475'. 10-3/4" casing was cemented at 94 feet and 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " at 3515 with 100 sx. The operator does not indicate that the well was perforated or fracked after the casing was set. The well record filed showed that the well was temporarily abandoned March 19, 1957.

Form C-103 filed by El Paso Natural Gas Company states that they purchased the well and were taking over operations. Our records do not reflect that El Paso has done any work on the well since taking it over.
