DETAILS OF WORK

4-28-63. Moved in, rigged up work-over unit. Pulled rods and tubing. Pulled 4" liner. Cleaned out to FMS 4454'. Run and landed 4", 11.6#/ft., flush-joint liner at 4422' with 2 open hole packers at 3893' and 3841'. Hanger packer set in 3 1/2" casing at 4798 feet. Liner perforations are 3909-4383. Fracture treated interval 3841-4422 with 1750 barrels crude oil. 5-3-63. Well flowed 58 barrels load oil and died after overnight shut-in. Now running tubing and rods to place well on pump. Lost 1692 barrels load oil.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
