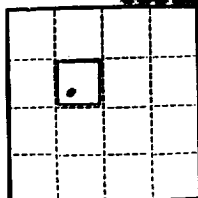

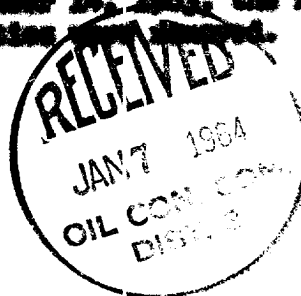

DETAILS OF WORK

The Federal 17-32 Well No. 2 recovered 23 barrels leak oil in the first 11 days of December, 1963. On December 12, 1963, the flowline from well ruptured. 23 barrels of leak oil remain to be recovered. On December 14, 1963, the rods and tubing were pulled from the well and all surface facilities were removed. The well is now shut-in.
