INSTRUCTIONS

In the event of establishing a residence and intent will residues report according to all types of lands and areas in either a single or multiple intervals, Federal and State laws and regulations, any section of special instructions concerning the use of this form and the use of the land or area in either a single or multiple intervals, or in regard to specific areas, or regulations, policies and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from the Bureau of Land Management, Bureau of Reclamation, or the State Lands Board, before preparing separate reports for separate intervals.

On the same day, summary report is submitted, copies of all currently available maps, schedules, permits, sample and other data on all types of lands and areas in either a single or multiple intervals, and other data, and other federal surveys, should be attached hereto, to the extent required by applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations and/or

There are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal regulations. (See also Item 12)

There are no specific requirements for reporting intervals where one reference is given for lands' boundaries known in either space in this form and in the case of this field is completed for separate productive areas more than one interval (multiple intervals), no state in item 12, and in item 13, should the same be reported in item 12, and number of (if any) for only the interval reported, in item 13, submit a separate report (page 2).

Intervals reported in item 12, and intervals reported in item 13, should show the additional data pertinent to each interval. Intervals reported in item 12, and intervals reported in item 13, should show the details of any multiple usage occurring and the location of the productive area.
