Mr. R. Q. Lee, who apparently is in charge of the A. G. Hill wells in 25N, 2W, dropped in this office a few days ago to file the enclosed forms. He stated that he had just learned that it was necessary to make reports on their operations to the state as well as to the federal government, in spite of the fact that they are drilling on federal land. Since there is no need for having these approved by your office, I am sending a copy of each C-103 for your files.

He stated that the Hill White No. 1-X, which the U.S.G.S. required him to move 330' from the center of the quarter-section after he had spudded, has been completed as a gas well and is now shut-in and awaiting tests.
