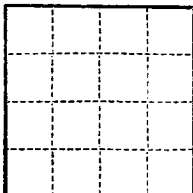

DETAILS OF WORK

SPUNNER: 6:00 P.M., 12/29/57.

Ran & set 10-3/4" OD casing at 330' & cemented with 300 lbs. reg. cement, 2% CaCl. Cement circulated.

DRILL STEM TEST NO. 1 440 - 530'.

Tool open 1 hr. with very weak blow of air throughout. Recovered 128' slightly water-out mud, 30 min. initial shut in pressure 65#, IFF 22#, FFF 62#, 1 hr. SIDHP 65#, Hyd. pressure 195#.

DRILL STEM TEST NO. 2 1000 - 1225'.

Tool open 2 hrs. with weak blow of air for 35 min. & died. Recovered 100' of drilling mud & 125' slightly water-out drlg. mud, 30 min. initial shut in pres. 162#, IFF 195#, FFF 95#, 1 hr. SIDHP 195#, Hyd. pres. in 550', out 483#.
