DETAILS OF WORK

Run & set 5 1/2" casing at 6366' with 2-stage tool set at 3691'. Cemented around shoe with 200 sks. reg. cement, 2% gel. Cemented thru 2-stage tool set at 3691' with 400 sks. reg. cement, 2% gel.

DRILL STEM TEST NO. 1 6070-6300' inside 5 1/2" casing to test perms. 6150-51'. Tool open 2 hrs. w/fair blow air thruout. Recovered 120' oil-cut water. IFF 55%, PFF 85%, 30 min. SIMMP 115%, Hyd. press. 2633# in & out.

Perforated 5 1/2" casing 6031-35', 6040-44', 6048-70', 6083-98', 6110-90', 6145-90' w/4 Schlumberger jet shots per ft. Total of 70', 280 shots.
