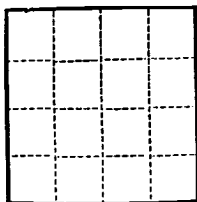

C. (6 sh/ft.) 3517-3522; (2 sh/ft.) 3522-3530; one 1 1/2" bullet at 3520'. Fired w/ 49,500 gallons water and 40,000 sand. Max. pr. 1675, avg. tr. pr. 1500. I.R. 73 B/M.
