Gentlemen:

We are in the process of completing the Gallup formation in our Jicarilla-Apache 28-1 well, which is located 1980' FSL, 1980' FEL, Section 28, T25N, R4W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The Dakota formation from which this well has produced since October, 1959, has been shut-off for this test.

We propose to empty our two 400 barrel stock tanks, Nos. 2966 and 2967, of Dakota crude and use these tanks to gauge and store the Gallup crude while testing the well. The Dakota crude emptied from these tanks will be transferred to frac tanks on the location for use as load oil.
