Frased Pictured Cliffs formation down 5 1/2" casing, thru above perfor. w/40,000# 20-40 sand & 40,000 gals. of water, using 60 rubber frac balls. BDP 1500#, Max. TP 1800#, Min. TP 1500#, inj. rate 70.3 BPM
