DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill Well No. 18 to approximately 6400' to test the Gallup formation. Our casing program is as follows:

300' of 10-3/4" OD 32.75# N-40 casing with 250 sacks regular cement to be circulated.

6400' of 5-1/2" OD 15.5# J-55 casing with 450 sacks regular cement.

The designated drilling unit is the SE 1/4 - NE 1/4 of Section 28-28N-3W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

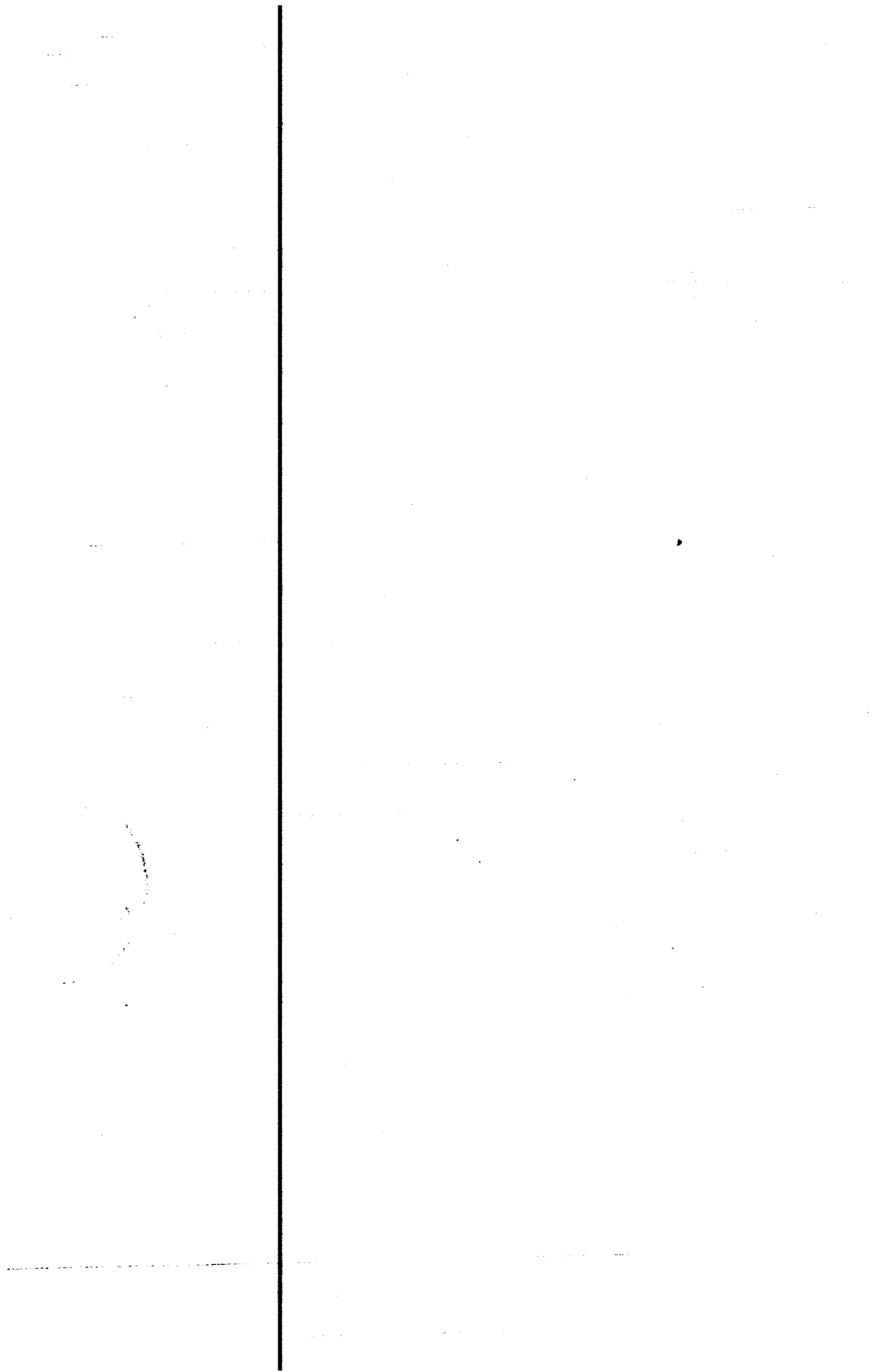

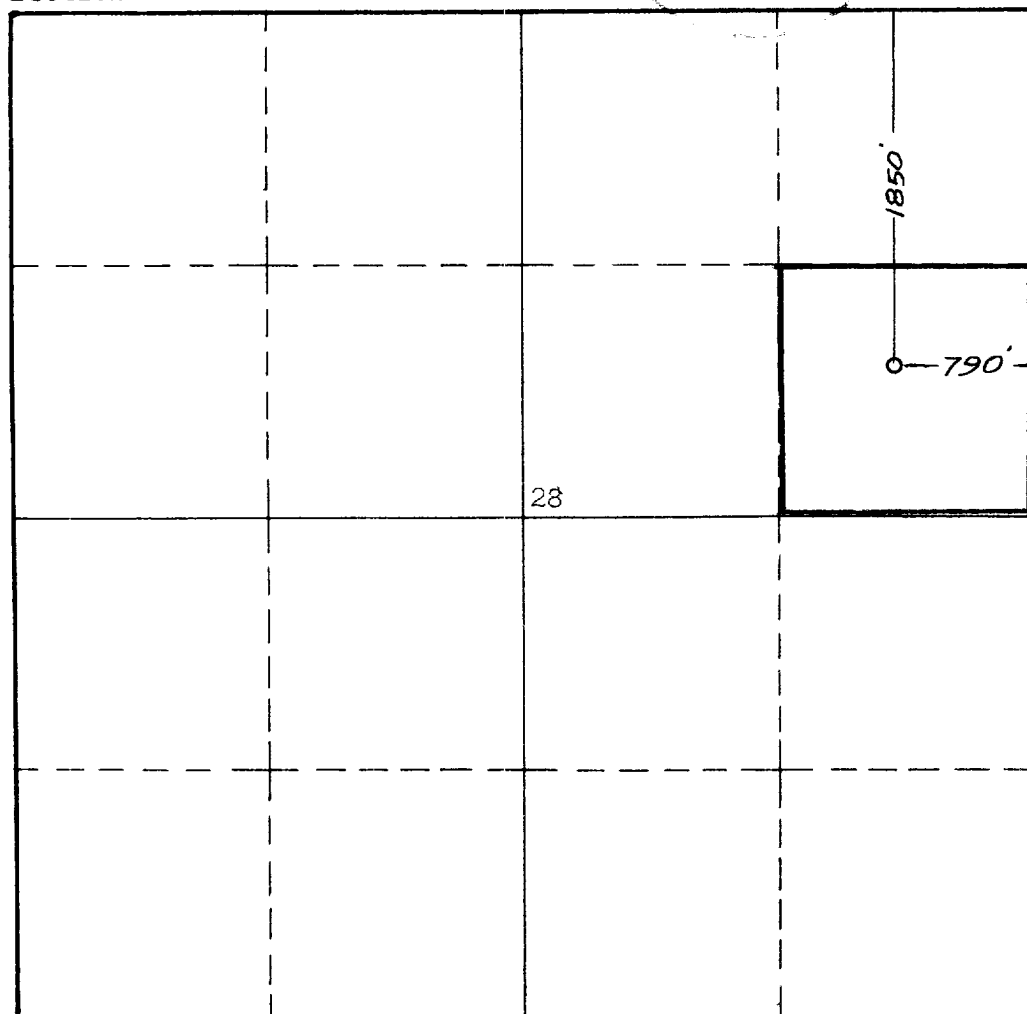
