## Gentlemen:

Petro-Atlas, Inc., Bishop #1 and Bishop #2, located in Units D and L, respectively, in Section 26, Township 25 North, Range 3 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, commenced producing gas into the El Paso Natural Gas Company line on February 10, 1960. The initial deliverability tests for these wells were originally scheduled during the early part of March. Due to adverse weather and road conditions, it was not possible to commence the flow tests until March 15, 1960. Due to the producing test phase of the test being delayed, it will not be possible for us to submit the test data prior to the expiration of the 45 day period. As the wells commenced producing February 10, the normal deadline would be March 25.

In accordance with Order No. R-333-C & D, we wish to request a fifteen (15) day extension for submitting Form C-122-A, reporting the initial deliverability test data for our Bishop #1 and #2. The actual tests will be completed prior to March 25, however, the data probably will not be ready for submittal prior to March 31, 1960.
