This location was necessary due to the topography of the area and I am therefore enclosing an engineer's plat, prepared by Mr. James P. Leese, which indicates the location and the topography.

I would like to receive administrative approval for this location so that our well can be completed. I have submitted all appropriate forms to Mr. Emery C. Arnold, at Aztec, New Mexico, and the approval of our form C-110 is pending your acceptance of this location.

San Juan Gas Corporation owns the operating rights on Lease Number N.M. 03991 located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 25, Township 25 North, Range 2 West. This is the only lease within a radius of 790 feet of this well and therefore, no other operator is involved.

Will you please notify Mr. Arnold when you approve this location.

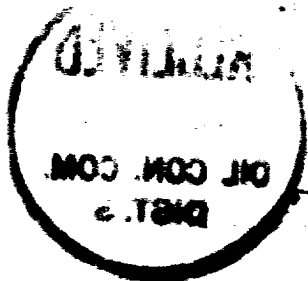
