ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Skelly Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 22, 1960, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla "C" Well No. 17 located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 28, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Otero-Chacra Pool.

Now, on this 12th day of October, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Skelly Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "C" Well No. 17 located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 28, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Otero-Chacra Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE SOUTH  
BLANCO-CLIFFE POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE  
OTTAWA-CLIFFE POOL.

Now, on this 12th day of October, 1960, the Secretary  
Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the  
provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's  
rules and regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided  
that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the  
waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause  
waiver nor impair correlative rights;
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion  
are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Skelly Oil Company, be and the  
same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Lucasilla  
WELL No. 17 located in the NW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 2  
NORTH, RANGE 2 WEST, NPM, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH  
A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE SOUTH BLANCO-  
CLIFFE POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE OTTAWA-  
CLIFFE POOL through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate  
and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section

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PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Otero-Chacra Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of conservative rights upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the absence of conservation.
