

THE APPLICATION OF CONTINENTAL OIL
COMPANY FOR A TRIPLE COMPLETION
(COMBINATION)

ORDER NO. MC-1210

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Continental Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 18, 1962, for permission to triply complete its Jicarilla Apache 28 Well No. 2 located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 27, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from an undesignated Mesaverde Pool and oil from the Gallup formation and Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 9th day of July, 1962, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed triple completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed triple completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to triply complete its Jicarilla Apache 28 Well No. 2 located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 27, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Mesaverde Pool and oil from the Gallup formation and Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of 2 7/8-inch, 4 1/2-inch and 4 1/2-inch casing, respectively, cemented in a common well bore with 2 3/8 inch tubing installed in the 4 1/2-inch casing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take communication tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Mesaverde Zone.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause



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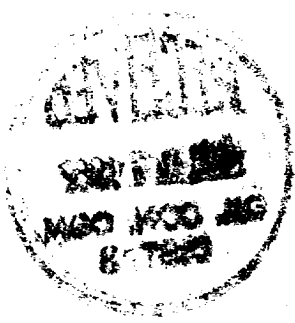
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
