DETAILS OF WORK

3-12-58 TD 3869' RKB. Cleaned out to 3829'. Perforated 3756-66', 3791-94', 3802-3809' with 4 shots per foot. Sandfraced with 23,000 gallons water and 30,000# sand, flushed with 3,660 gallons of water. Breakdown pressure 800#, broke to 500#. Treating pressure 1500#. Dropped 20 rubber balls, pressure increased to 1800#. Dropped 20 more rubber balls,; pressure increased to 2100#, dropped to 1000# during flush. Average injection rate 51.2 BPM.

3-14-58 After 48 hours flowing 264 MCF/day.
