HISTORY OF OIL OR GAS WELL

It is of the greatest importance to have a complete history of the well. Please state in detail the dates of redrilling, together with the reasons for the work and its results. If there were any changes made in the casing, state fully, and if any casing was "sidetracked" or left in the well, give its size and location. If the well has been dynamited, give date, size, position, and number of shots. If plugs or bridges were put in to test for water, state kind of material used, position, and results of pumping or bailing.

The well was drilled to a total depth of 3750 m/a completion depth of 3728.

Set 154' of 8-5/8" csg at 166' w/125 sax reg. neat cmt. Cmt. circulated.

Set 3741' of 4-1/2" csg at 3750' w/225 sax 8 1/2 gal and 100 sax neat cement.

Perf'd 4-1/2" csg from 3638-3640 w/4 bullet shots/feet. Waterfraced thru perms w/ 43,470 gals water and 50,000# sand. Avg. Inf. Rate 40 bbls/min at 2100-1750#. Used 81 perf. ball sealers.

Set 3619' of 2" tubing at 3627'.

Swabbed well, well kicked off, blew to clean. Well shut in for test.

After 7-day shut in, and after 3-hour blowdown, well produced gas at rate of 1872 Mcf/day thru 3/4" chokes.

Completed as a flooding gas well in the Pictured Cliffs Formation thru parts in 4-3/2" casing from 1630-3660.

0.011 shut in, no pipeline connection.
