Pursuant to our telephone conversation today I would like to request tentative approval of a proposed dual completion of Pictured Cliffs and Chacra gas pays in our Kay Kimbell 1-22 Salazar Federal well located in Section 22 25N 6W, Rio Arriba County.

We have perforated and fraced through $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch casing with perforations from 3416 to 3528 feet in the Chacra sandstone.

We propose to perforate and frac the Pictured Cliffs gas zone from 2568 to 2576 feet. We then propose to dually produce these pays with production packer set at 2600 feet, 2 inch tubing bottomed at 3450 feet, and side door choke set ten to fifteen above the Pictured Cliffs perforations.
