DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is proposed to perforate the existing string of 2 7/8" casing opposite the Point Lookout section of the Mesa Verde formation. The Point Lookout section is encountered at a depth of 5829". Perforating will be done by the orientation method. The Point Lookout section will be sand-water fraced after perforating.

This well was previously approved by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission as a triple completion in the Gallup, Greenhorn, and Bakota formations. The Greenhorn proved to be non-commercial and the Greenhorn perforations in the 2 7/8" casing were isolated by setting a bridge plug above the top of the Greenhorn.

Administrative approval has been requested from the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to perform this work.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
