We request permission to initially produce our Walter Howard #1 and Federal 30 H-1 through 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing.

These wells were drilled during October and November of 1959 and because of the steel strike we were unable to purchase tubing. At this time we have the tubing, but due to the muddy condition of the roads it is almost impossible to move in a rig to run the tubing. We request permission to produce through the casing until May 1, 1960. At that time we should be able to tube the wells without difficulty.
