8400' of 5-1/2" OD casing, 150, cemented with 600 sks. cement.

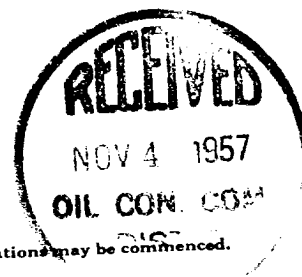
The designated drilling unit is the 18/4 of Section 18-25N-3W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

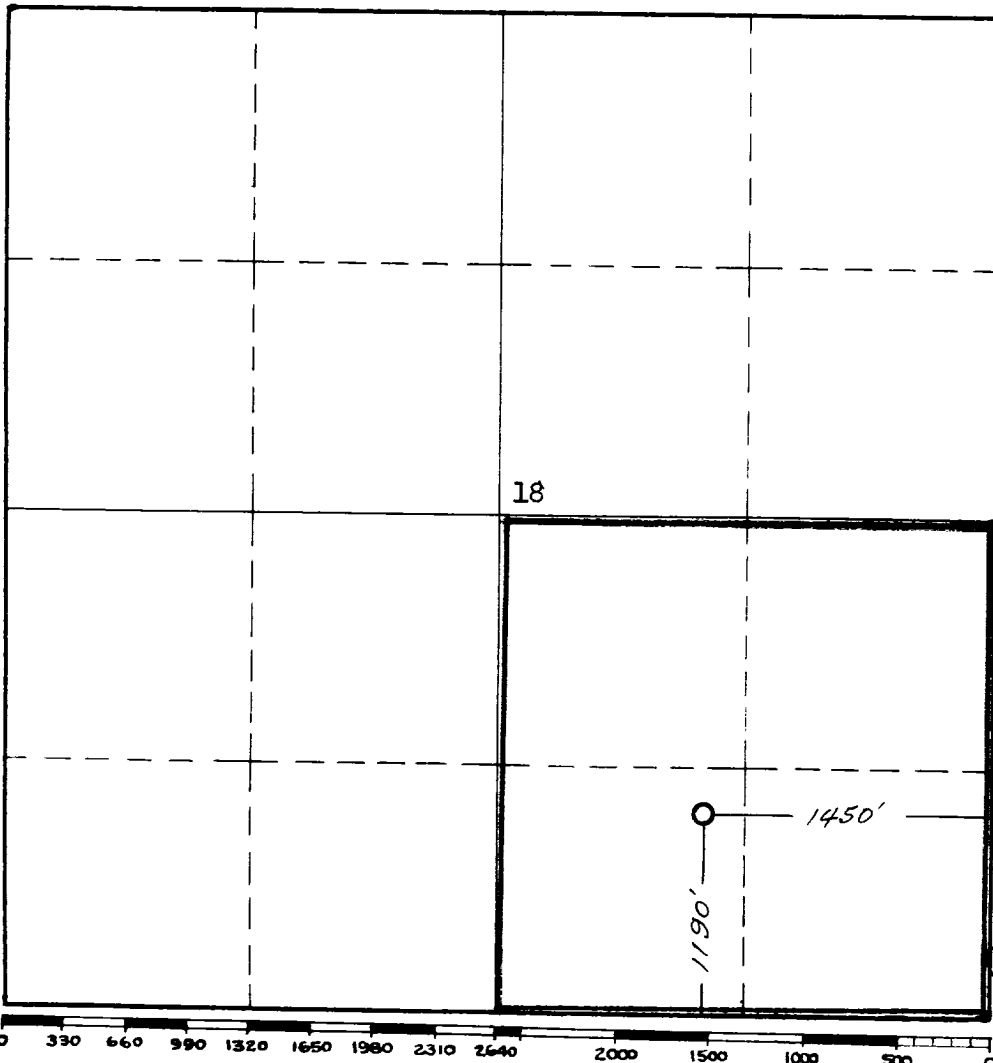
