

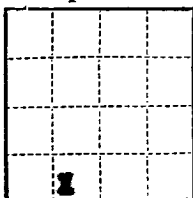

DETAILS OF WORK

Navajo Contract 148 No. 10. On September 30, 1958, 3-1/2" liner was set at 3400' - 7777' with Beach Rock Lead Seal Hanger and cemented with 900 sacks of gal followed by 50 sacks neat cement. Temperature survey showed good cement top to lining 3-1/2" liner at 7900' with possible cement stringer up to 8200'. Run 200 tool set at 3340' to squeeze top of liner. Was unable to pump around top liner with 9000'. Drilled cement in 3-1/2" casing 7671' to 7777'. Displaced mud in casing with water. Tested top of 3-1/2" liner with 2000', which held with no drop in pressure.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
