DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to plug and abandon this well in the following manner:

1. Run wire line to tag top of fish or collapsed casing.
2. Pump in 25 sacks cement w/a top rubber plug to 50' above collapsed casing.
3. Spot a 15 sack cement plug on the inside of 4 1/2" casing and a 15 sack plug in the annulus.
4. Erect a 4' x 3" dry hole marker.



Understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
