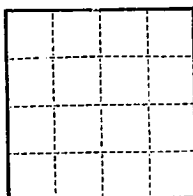

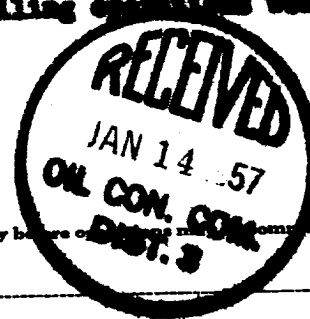
On January 5, 1957, the above well was spudded, and on January 8, 1957, 10-3/4" casing was set at 480 feet with 330 sacks cement. After waiting on cement for twenty-four hours, casing and water shut off were tested with 600 pounds pressure for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
