DETAILS OF WORK

Fred Phillips "C" Well No. 2 was spudded on November 12, 1958, and on November 12, 1958, 8-5/8" casing was landed at 215 feet with 160 sacks cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut-off were tested with 400 pounds pressure for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
