DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

10 3/4" csg. on Nov. 7 set at 87' & cemented to surface with 65 sacks. Allowed cement to set 24 hours. Applied 500 PSI pump pressure for 30 minutes before drilling plug. Pressure held O. K.

5 1/2" 15.5# casing cemented at 3478' with 200 sacks. Plug pumped down with water. Final pump pressure 700 PSI. Held same on pipe 12 hours before releasing - No drop in pressure. Moved cable tool rig on well. Found water standing at surface indicating no leak. Swabbed water out to top of plug (Float Collar). Ran bailer to check for fluid ingress above plug; found none; hole remained dry for 1 hour. Drilled plug.
