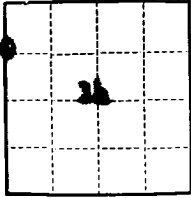

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Ran 118 joints 5 1/2", 4-55, 15.5% casing on October 10, 1958, landed at 3920 F.B. Unable to break circulation.
2. Perforated 6 shots/ft. from 3874 to 3875 and cemented casing with 150 sacks regular cement with 2 1/2 gal on October 13, 1958.
3. Cleaned out hole to F.B. F. B. of 3870 on October 23, 1958.
4. Perforated 6 shots/ft. from 3816 to 3890 on October 24, 1958.
5. Sand Water Free. above perforations with 86,520 gallons of water and 100,000 lbs. of sand.
6. Ran 123 joints 2", 4-706, 4-55 tubing on October 25, 1958, landed at 3841 ft. F.B.
