

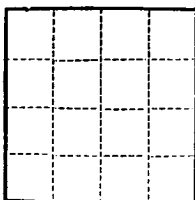

DETAILS OF WORK

T.D. 3164', 8-1/8" @ 303', 4-1/2" @ 2360' with stub at 1633' KB. Flipped 3164'-2360'. Bridge Plug at 2364'. Calculated top of cement within 4-1/2" casing at 1673' following squeeze job. Retrievable cementer stuck in 4-1/2" at 1700'.

**WORK DONE:** Flipped stub of 4-1/2" 1633'-1600' with 14 sacks cement. Placed cap on 8-1/8" surface casing. Cleaned up location and graded road. Completed work 6-20-60. Turned well over to U.S. Forest Service for water well (see attached letter). They will see location and road with erected wheat grass.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
