Dear Sir:

This is in reference to your telecon request for information concerning Jicarilla Contract 146 No. 10. The subject well had shown a very drastic decline in production since early 1968. There were several indications of fluid logging off the well and an attempt to displace the fluid and dry up the well bore area via gas injection was initiated on December 9, 1970. After injecting about 27,500 MCF of gas, the well was put on line December 17, 1970. The well blew down and again showed signs of logging off before the load gas was recovered. A compressor was installed on January 3, 1971, the load gas was recovered, and the well finaled at a rate of 520 MCFD on February 5, 1971.
