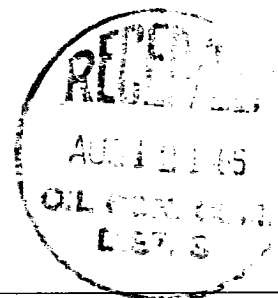

Spudded 7-1-65. Drilled 11" hole to 207'. Ran 6 jt. 8-5/8" casing, landed at 207' RB and cemented with 150 sacks regular. Tested surface pipe at 600# for 30 minutes. Held O.K. Drilled to 3875'. Ran 122 jts. 4 1/2" casing, set at 3875' and cemented with 175 sacks neat. Perforated Lower Pictured Cliffs 3777-86' with 2 jets per foot. Fraced with 27,940 gallons water and 35,000# sand. BP set at 3760'. Perforated Upper Pictured Cliffs 3740-43' with 2 jets per foot. Fraced with 13,130 gallons water and 15,000# sand. Pulled BP. 2-3/8" tubing set at 3760'.

Completed 7-18-65 from above perforations for a rate of 1882 MCVD on 3/4" choke. Shut-in 24 hours, CP 900#, TP 900#. Flowed 1 1/2 hours. CP 475#, TP 150#. Shut-in awaiting pipeline connection. Southern Union will be the gas purchaser.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
