DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded January 7, 1957. Drilled 11" hole to total depth of 75 feet. Cemented 8-5/8" casing at 71 feet with 50 sacks regular cement; pressured plug to 500 pounds and held for one hour. Drilled out cement and started new hole on January 8, 1957. Drilled 7-7/8" hole to total depth of 3700' and ran Electrical Survey to 3700'. Set 5-1/2" casing at 3683' with 75 sacks of poxmix; 75 sacks regular, 4% gel, and 1/4 pound floccs to a sack. Pressured plug to 1000 pounds and held for one hour.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may commence.
