

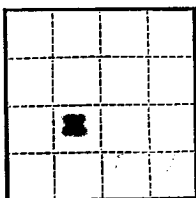

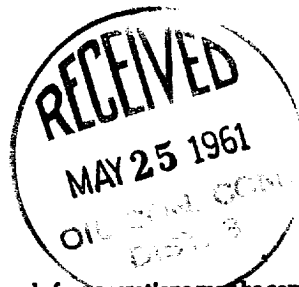

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Spudded 12-1/4" hole on March 18, 1961, and drilled to 535'. Set 8-1/2" casing at 535' with 300 sacks cement containing 25 Galena Chloride. Circulated 90 sacks cement. After waiting on cement, tested 8-1/2" casing with 900 psi for 30 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 535' and resumed drilling operations.
