Reference is made to your application for approval of a 185.82-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Stevie Joe Well No. 6, located 960 feet from the North line and 2480 feet from the West line of said Section 6.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 185.82 acres.
