Spudded 6-7-63. Drilled 12 1/4" hole to 202'. Ran 6 jts. 8-5/8", 240 casing, set at 202' and cemented with 150 sacks regular. Drilled to 3883'. Ran 123 jts. 4 1/2", 10.5# casing, landed at 3883' and cemented with 150 sacks regular and 150 cu. ft. stratacrets followed by 75 sacks neat. Perforated Chacra 3746-50', 3756-62', and treated with 31,500 gallons water, 35,000# sand and 300# "Adonite Aqua" additive. Set Model "D" packer at 3707'. Perforated Pictured Cliffs 2873-75', 2906-10', 2911-18', 2920-24'. Treated with 29,800 gallons fresh water, 30,000# sand and 8 gallons "Adonite" additive. Ran 114 jts. 1 1/4" tubing and 90 jts. 1" tubing. Completed as a dual gas well 7-2-63. Chacra flowed 1776 MCFD, 3/4" choke. Pictured Cliffs flowed 604 MCFD, 3/4" choke. Gas purchaser is Southern Union Gas Co.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
