Spudded 8/4/66. Five joints 9 5/8" casing set at 173' and cemented with 100 sacks cement. Drilled to TD 3900'. Ran 4 1/2" casing to 3900' and cemented with 150 sacks regular, 150 cu. ft. Stratocrete & 75 sacks neat. Chacra perfs 3774'-80', 3784'-91', & 3799'-3807' fraced with 28,980 gals. water, 35,000# sand, "ADOMITE AQUA" additive and 5 gals. "ADOMALL" additive. Packer set at 3735'. Pictured Cliffs perfs 2902'-12' and 2933'-43' fraced with 39,690 gals. water and 35,000# sand plus 5 gals. "ADOMALL" additive. Landed 1 1/2" tubing in Model "D" packer at 3735' to produce Chacra. Ran 2900' of 1" tubing to produce Pictured Cliffs. Swabbing. Waiting on final tests.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
