Dear Mr. August:

Enclosed are approved copies of Forms C-104 and C-110 relative to your #1 Mobil Federal well located in the  $CE_{i}^{L}$  Section  $3\acute{e}+24N+1K$ . You will note that I have approved the C-110 for a 60-day period to allow you to make a production test to determine the production characteristics of this well. As soon as your load oil has been recovered we are requesting that you conduct a gas-cil ratio test and submit it to this office.

I am also enclosing a copy of a telegram received in this office from Mobil Oil Company advising that they are willing to designate the SE Section 36 Township 24N-1W as the spacing unit. I am sending a supply of acreege dedication plats and request that you submit three copies of this form indicating a Jedication of 160-acres, being the SE of Section 36 The form should be signed by you as operator as indicated but it will not be necessary that it be signed by the surveyor I also neplected to mention to you on the telephone the other day that this well is not a standard gas well location by our rules. Our rules regulre that a gas well location be located a minimum of 790 feet from the unit boundary. Your well is located only 660 feet from the unit boundary. Therefore if the well is to be produced as a gas well it will be necessary that you make application for a hearing before the Oi' and Gas Conservation Commission in Santa Fe for the approval of the non-standard location prior to expiration of the test period. If the well turns out to be an oil well the location is a standard oil well location, as an oil well need be only 330 feet from the boundary of the 40-acre tract upon which it is located.
