Dear Sir:

On February 18, 1965 we received in this office two copies of Federal Form 9-330, "Well Completion Report" for your #1 Mobil Federal well located in the SE_2^1 Section 36-24N-1W. The same date we also received Form C-104, "Request for Allowable" and Form C-110, "Authorization to Transport" for the same well.

On the Federal Well Record form the potential was shown to be 75 barrels of oil and 635 MF of gas in 24 hours. Form C-104 indicated that the potential was 635 MF of gas per day with no mention being made that any oil was produced. I have noted that the well was sand-oil fracked with 1025 barrels of oil and I am wondering if the oil volume shown on the Federal report does not consist of load oil. It will be necessary for us to know what the potential of the well actually is in order to know whether to assign it an oil or gas allowable.
