Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to Rule 303-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations for the subject dually completed well to permit the removal of the down-hole separation equipment and to commingle the production from both pools in the well-bore.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception pursuant to the provisions of Rule 303-C, and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such down-hole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above and Commission Order No. MC-1683, which authorized the dual completion and required separation of the zones, is hereby placed in abeyance.

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 303-C, total commingled oil production from the subject well shall not exceed 50 barrels per day, and total water production from the well shall not exceed 100 barrels per day. The maximum amount of gas which may be produced daily from the well shall be determined by multiplying 2,000 by top unit allowable for the Dakota formation.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis:

Upper Pool: 45%
Lower Pool: 55%

Location:

Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to the 50% of the Commission Rules and Regulations for the subject property, and to the removal of the down-hole separator and to continue the production from both wells in the wellhead.

It is noted that the above-mentioned wells are located for a gravel for a well exception to stand to the provisions of Rule 50-6, and that the removal of the separator will not result from each down-hole separator, and the relative rights will not be affected thereby, you are hereby authorized to continue the production as described above and Commission Order No. 580-63, which authorized the said production and required separation at the wellhead, is hereby placed in effect.

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 50-6, total combined production from the said well shall not exceed 20 barrels per day, and total water production from the well shall not exceed 10 barrels per day. The maximum amount of gas which may be produced daily from the well shall be determined by multiplying 2.00 by the unit allowable for the Dakota formation.

Payment of royalty to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis:

Upper Pool: 45%
Lower Pool: 55%
