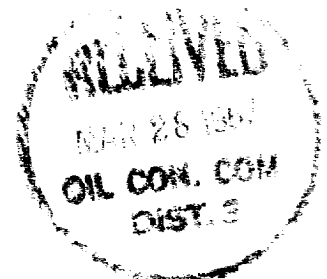
Please consider this letter as Skelly Oil Company's application to dual complete its Jicarilla "C" Well No. 13 and in support thereof provides as follows:

1. That the applicant is the operator of this lease which contains 2560 acres and is described as the S/2 Section 21 and S/2 Section 22; all of Section 27 and 28; N/2 Section 33 and N/2 of Section 34, all in Township 25 North and Range 5 West, Rio Arriba County.

2. That the applicant's Jicarilla "C" Well No. 13 is located 990' from the North line and 1650' from the East line of Section 33 -25N-5W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

3. That the applicant dually completed the well in the following manner:

- a. Perforated 5-1/2" casing from 2766' to 2990' in the Pictured Cliffs.
- b. Perforated 5-1/2" casing from 3606' to 3654' and 3706' to 3750' in the Lewis Sand.
- c. Set Baker production type packer at 3560'. Landing nipple was set on top of production packer at 3559' with side door choke set in landing nipple, so the Pictured Cliffs can be produced through the annulus of the 5-1/2" casing and the Lewis Sand is produced through 2" tubing.



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4. That the granting of this application to produce this well as a dual completion from the Pictured Cliffs and Lewis Sand is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

5. That the manner and method of this dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

6. That a diagramatic sketch showing the producing intervals and the physical equipment used in dualling the well is attached.

7. That a plat showing the above described lands and all offset properties, indicating well locations and lease ownership to the best of our knowledge is attached.

8. That all offset operators are hereby notified by a copy of this application.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, applicant requests that the Secretary of the Commission grant Administrative approval to produce this well as a dual completion.

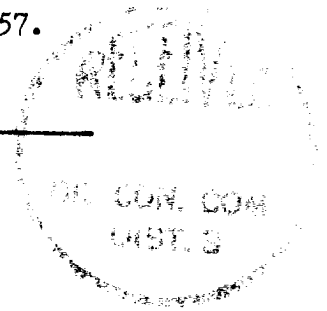
