The following was completed to BLM specifications as stated in letter dated 4-8-88.

1. A permanent monument was vemented in the wellbore. It is labeled with the operators name, well name & number, legal location, and lease number.
2. All fences, production equipment, purchaser's equipment, concrete slabs, deadman (anchors), flowlines, risers, debris and trash were removed from the location.
3. Oily soil & fluids were properly disposed of.
4. Pits were filled in and the edges of the pads shaped to conform to the natural terrain.
5. Pads were leveled, dressed up by a maintainer, ripped and disked.
6. Access roads were leveled, waterbarred, disked and blocked off with earthen berms at the junction with the main road and at the entrance of the well pad.
7. All disturbed areas were seeded 8-28-88.
