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Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to Rule 303-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations for the subject dually completed well to permit the removal of the down-hole separation equipment and to commingle the production from both pools in the well-bore.

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It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception pursuant to the provisions of Rule 303-C, and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such down-hole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above and Commission Order No. MC-1844, which authorized the dual completion and required separation of the zones, is hereby placed in abeyance.

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 303-C, total commingled oil production from the subject well shall not exceed 50 barrels per day, and total water production from the well shall not exceed 100 barrels per day. The maximum amount of gas which may be produced daily from the well shall be determined by multiplying 2,000 by top unit allowable for the Dakota formation.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis:

Upper Pool: 80%
Lower Pool: 20%

Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to Rule 11-1 of the Commission Rules and Regulations for the purpose of drilling a well to permit the removal of the down-hole casing from the well and to complete the well from both holes in the well-hole.

It appears that the subject well qualifies for removal to such extent as to the removal of Rule 11-1, and that the removal of the casing will not result in any down-hole flow. The well and associated equipment will not be violated by the removal of the casing and the production as described above and completion Order No. 11-1, which authorized the drilling and completion of the well, is hereby amended to read:

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 11-1, total completion of the well shall not exceed the subject well shall not exceed the well hole, and total water production from the well shall not exceed 100 barrels per day. The maximum amount of gas which may be produced from the well shall be determined by testing the well for water allowance for the Dakota formation.

Testing of the well for water allowance and completion of the well shall be on the following basis:

Upper Pool: 800
Lower Pool: 200
