

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Continental Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on May 26, 1969, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla 28 Well No. 8 located in Unit C of Section 28, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Gallup and Dakota formations through a single string of 2-inch tubing with the production from both zones commingled by means of a MMA Mandrel with RG double check valve incorporated in the tubing string and located at approximately 6730 feet.

Now, on this 15th day of June, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla 28 Well No. 8 located in Unit C of Section 28, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Gallup and Dakota formations through a single string of 2-inch tubing with the production from both zones commingled by means of a MMA Mandrel with RG double check valve incorporated in the tubing string and located at approximately 6730 feet.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

**PROVIDED FURTHER,** That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:** That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

Under the provisions of Rule 11-A, Continental Oil Company

May 10, 1969, for permission to finally complete its Well No. 1  
located in Unit C of Section 28, Township 33 North,  
Range 4 West, T10N, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner  
as to produce oil from the Guling and Bakken formations through a  
single string of 2-inch tubing with the production from both zones  
commingled by means of a MMA Handrel with 80 double check valve  
incorporated in the tubing string and located at approximately  
1730 feet.

Now, on this 15th day of June, 1969, the Secretary-Director  
finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 11-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators or offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rules.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause water not imperious corrective rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Continental Oil Company, do and its  
same is hereby authorized to finally complete its Well No. 1  
located in Unit C of Section 28, Township 33 North, Range 4  
West, T10N, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to  
produce oil from the Guling and Bakken formations through a single  
string of 2-inch tubing with the production from both zones  
commingled by means of a MMA Handrel with 80 double check valve  
incorporated in the tubing string and located at approximately 1730  
feet.

HOWEVER, THAT applicant shall complete, operate, and  
produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 11-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper-  
steps upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That production of this lease is  
hereby retained for the entry of each further order as the Com-  
mission may deem necessary.
