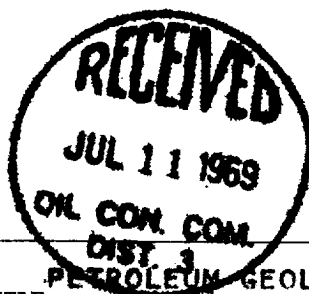

Instructions
