1. Drilled 9-7/8" hole to T.B. of 3200 ft. M.S.L. on 7/25/69. Cased 7-1/8", 10-1/2", 1-1/2" casing. Cemented at 1799 ft. M.S.L. Cemented with 1000 cu. ft. of cement. Plugged down at 1250 ft. 10/22/69.
2. Applied up and pressure tested casing and A.C.P. to 1000 psi for 10 minutes. Test OK.
3. Drilled 6-3/4" hole to T.B. of 7540 ft. M.S.L. cemented 10/27/69.
4. on 100 lbs. of 5-1/2", 10-50#, 1-55 casing as a liner. Bottom of liner at 7226 ft. M.S.L. Top of liner at 2051 ft. M.S.L. Cemented liner w/1100 cu. ft. of cement. Plugged down at 250 ft. 10/28/69.
5. Moved in completion rig 11/19/69. on 2-3/8", 1-1/2" tubing and changed out hole to 1-1/2" of 7226 ft. M.S.L.
6. Pressure tested casing to 3500 psi. Test OK.
7. on correlation log and cement bond log.
8. Perforated first stage matrix with 1 shot/ft. 7314-7316, 7316-7318, 7318-7320. Total of 51 holes. and water fraced perfor with 70,000# sand, 1000 glass beads and 57,000 gallons of 6/10 #1 water.
9. set 2-1/2" total 7-4 Baker bridge plug at 7221 ft. M.S.L. tested plug to 3500 psi. Test OK.
10. Perforated 2nd stage matrix w/2 shots/ft. 7186-7200. Total of 29 holes. and water fraced perfor w/30,000# sand, 500# glass beads and 36,900 gallons 6-8, #1 water.
11. on tubing sand bit and drilled out bridge plug at 7221 ft. M.S.L.

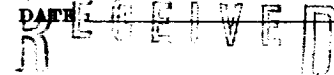
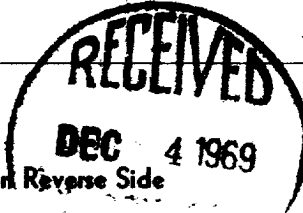

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
