This well was spudded on December 20, 1971. Drilled 12 1/4" hole to 235'. Ran seven joints of 8 5/8" OD, 24# casing set at 234' RB and cemented to surface with 250 sacks of Class "A" cement. Drilled 7 7/8" hole to 7970' total depth. Ran 259 joints 4 1/2" OD, 10.5# casing set at 7969' RB. Stage collar at 5993'. Cemented casing with 1156 sacks of cement.

Attached is our proposed down hole commingling installation prepared prior to the drilling of this well (Exhibit "A"). We propose to commingle the Gallup and Dakota zones and produce the well by conventional pumping methods as set forth in Administrative Order No. DHC-12 and New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. 4203 as follows:

Each well is permitted to produce commingled production at a rate not to exceed 50 BOPD and 100 BWPD. The amount of gas which may be produced daily from the commingled zones of each well shall be determined by multiplying 2,000 by the top unit allowable for the Gallup zone.

Instructions
