

THE APPLICATION OF SOUTHERN UNION
PRODUCTION COMPANY FOR A DUAL
COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2002

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Southern Union Production Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 27, 1972, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla "K" Well No. 18 located in Unit M of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Otero-Chacra Pool.

Now, on this 13th day of December, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from offsetting operators and the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be dispensed with in this instance.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southern Union Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "K" Well No. 18 located in Unit M of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Otero-Chacra Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

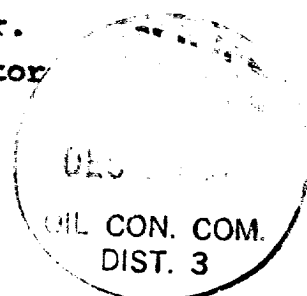
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

the "Y" Well No. 18 located in Unit B of Section 2, Township 13 North,
Range 2 West, NMPW, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in
such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs
and the Gero-Chavez Pool.

On or about November 1972, the Commission
received the following:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions
of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all
operators of offset wells have been duly notified and
that waivers of objection have been received from
offsetting operators and the waiting period as prescribed by said
Rule may be dispensed with in this instance.
- (3) That the proposed final completion will not cause
waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (4) That the new entry of the proposed final completion, etc.
feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southern Union Production Company,
do and the same is hereby authorized to drill completion in the "Y" Well No. 18
located in Unit B of Section 2, Township 13 North,
Range 2 West, NMPW, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner
as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and
the Gero-Chavez Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the
casing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate,
and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule
113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall seal packer-leakage
tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That jurisdiction of this cause is
hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the
Commission may deem necessary.
