Reference is made to your application of December 8, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Jicarilla 123 Well No. 17 to be located 1125 feet from the South line and 1655 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 6, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 of said Section 6 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.
