THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2328

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL COMSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Pule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on April 13, 1977, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla "67" Mell No. 18 located in Unit I of Section 19, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of das from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra formation adjacent to the Otero-Chacra Pool.

NOW, on this 14th day of April, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;
- (3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "67" Well No. 18 located in Unit I of Section 19, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra formation adjacent to the Otero-Chacra Pool through parallel strings of casing cemented in a common well-bore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take communciation tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
