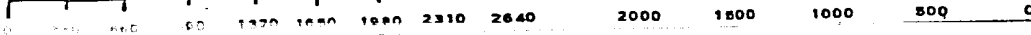

Dear Mr. Davis:

We have recently received an archeological survey report entitled, "An Archaeological Survey Report, One Well Location in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, for Cotton Petroleum, Location Apache #26." This report was written by Ms. Penelope Whitten, numbered 233, and dated December 19, 1979. We understand that you also have a copy of this report.

We have reviewed this report and note that no cultural resources were encountered during the requisite field inspection. Therefore, no effect upon significant cultural resources is expected. Accordingly, archeological clearance is granted under the following stipulations:

1. that all land altering activity be confined to the archeologically surveyed area; and
2. that in the event subterranean cultural resources are encountered, land alteration be halted and the Area Archeologist notified.
